- Cruise boarding pass!!!
- Photo ID (License/passport)!!!
- Credit/debit card
- Cash (can't use it on the ship but may need it while on shore)
- Medicare card

- Camera / Phone

- Underwear, socks
- Nighty / Pjs (cabins might be warm overnight)
- Comfortable walking shoes, dressy shoes for dinner, thongs for the pool/shower/beach
- Comfortable clothing for day (mix and match is good) - Preferably Hatter colours!
- Dressier clothing for night (especially formal night) - Preferably Hatter colours!
- Cardigan/jumper etc. for if the weather is cold.
- Raincoat or disposable rain poncho just in case
- Swimwear for the pools (Pool towels are provided)
- Bling & Hatter Accessories                       Kazoo!     Regalia (For Queens)

- Chargers for any electronics
- US to AU plug (Not-surge protected!) powerboard or double adaptor
- Magnetic hooks for walls/door to hang decorations etc.
- Torch (for loo visits) or a battery powered candle
- Pegs for hanging bathers in the shower     Magnet hooks for hanging hats on walls
- Highlighter for marking the Princess Patter
- Hanging toiletries holder
- Travel size Hand sanitiser
- Water bottle (for shore excursions), Travel Mug
- Post-it-notes (for leaving messages for cabinmates)
- Plastic bag for wet bathers/dirty clothes

Make sure the cruise ship paper luggage tags (printable with your boarding pass) are on each item of luggage.

### Princess Alcohol policy

One 750ml (no larger) bottle of wine or champagne onboard per voyage, which will not be subject to a corkage fee if consumed in Your stateroom. Additional wine or champagne bottles are welcome, but will incur a \$15 corkage fee each, irrespective of where they are intended to be consumed. Liquor, spirits, or beers are not permitted. Any beverages purchased during the cruise at any port of call will be collected at the gangway for safekeeping and will be delivered to Your stateroom on the last day of the cruise.
